

# Rules for Project Iron Quilter

Competition starts promptly at 10AM on June 4, 2011. Quilts will be auctioned off immediately after the competition to benefit Gilda's Club of Rochester, New York.

## Prizes include;

1 Bernette Sewing Machine (a \$600 value) made for Bernina  
75 fat quarters for viewers choice  
2 irons  
Australian fabric and many more sewing items.

## Each contestant may bring:

Fabric: 1 piece up to 1 yard in length  
Backing fabric if you wish...but you may not use it in the front of the quilt  
Batting if you wish...we will furnish it  
Embellishments: Up to the equivalent of one shoe box full  
Fusible web, stabilizer...anything similar you might wish to use in the construction of your quilt  
Thread: As much as you like  
Basic Sewing Supplies  
Sewing Machine, extension cord  
Rotary cutter, mat, ruler...we will have one extra cutting table  
Quilting templates, tools, whatever you can't leave home without

## Rules:

Quilt must be finished to be considered for a prize.  
Finishing can be something as simple as zig zagging around the edges, or binding, pillowcasing, facing, or any other method we haven't mentioned.

Quilts must be at least 18" by 18" although we encourage you to make them larger. There will be a prize for the largest quilt.

Our definition of a quilt is that it consists of three layers.

We will furnish sleeves and labels. (They don't have to be applied during competition time and we will take care if it)
